M. Tech (Self Finance) Admissions: A.Y. 2026-2027 **Online and Physical Reporting Instructions for Provisionally Selected Candidates**

The provisionally selected candidates are informed to follow the instructions given below strictly:

1. The candidates, whose final results published and/or awaited are advised to note that they should obtain:
 - i). at least 60% aggregate marks or 6.5 CGPA on a 10-point scale.
 - ii). SC/ST/PwD candidates with 55% aggregate marks or 6.0 CGPA on 10-point scale.
 - iii). In case, the result of qualifying degree is awaited, provisional admission is permitted to a candidate subject to meeting above minimum qualifying degree requirements latest by **September 30, 2026**. In these cases, all exams should have been completed by **August 15, 2026**. A certificate from the Head of the Current Institute to that effect should be submitted during document verification.

Important Note about Accommodation:

At present, renovation works in several hostel buildings are in progress. Therefore, hostel accommodation within the Institute campus will not be provided to students admitted under the M.Tech. (Self-Finance) Programs.

- Each provisionally selected candidate is required to pay **the seat acceptance fee of Rs. 1,02,500/-** (which comprises of tuition fee of Rs. 50,000/- for first semester, contingency of Rs. 10,000 for first semester, and other fee of Rs. 42,500/- for first year) (full details are available at <https://admissions.nitw.ac.in/impinstructions/>) **by using the links given inside your NITWAS ERP login.**
- If the candidate fails to pay the seat acceptance fee within the stipulated time (i.e., during 22-23, June 2026) of Phase-I schedule, the candidate will lose his/her claim on the allotted seat (that means the candidate's provisional seat allotment will be cancelled automatically).
- The vacancies arising due to non-payment of seat acceptance fee by the provisionally selected candidates in the Phase-I will be filled by the respective category candidates in the remaining phases from the waiting list.**

The provisional selection lists of **Phase-II and Phase-III**, if there are any vacant seats, of all such candidates will be released on **25th June, 2026 (Thursday)** and **3rd July, 2026 (Friday)** respectively and no separate call letters shall be sent to the candidates.

- The candidates are required to report physically to the Institute (visit the institute website for exact dates and no separate call letters shall be sent to the candidates), failing which their allotted seat will be cancelled and the fee deposited will be refunded as per the refund policy of the Institute, which is available at <https://admissions.nitw.ac.in/impinstructions/>. If any changes are there in physical reporting schedule, it will be notified on the Institute website only. Hence, the candidates are informed to visit the Institute website regularly for all latest updates.

6. If any candidate wants to cancel his/her allotted seat before physical reporting, he/she can send a request for cancellation to the Associate Dean (Admissions) through email: admissions@nitw.ac.in and admissions.pg@nitw.ac.in. In that case, the candidate should provide the bank account details (Name of the account holder, Account Number, Name of the bank branch, IFSC code) along with the proof (either a copy of cancelled cheque or stamped front page of pass book of the same bank account). The account must be in the name of the candidate only. The refund amount will be transferred to the candidate's bank account only after entire admission process is completed.
7. The PwD candidates will be required to undergo the medical examination by the medical board constituted by the Institute at the time of physical reporting. Based on medical examination, if the medical board finds the candidate ineligible for PwD category at that time, her/his seat may be cancelled.
8. **The eligible refund amount to the candidate who cancels the admission before physical reporting is the balance amount after an amount of Rs. 5,000 deducted towards the processing fee from the fee paid.**

If a candidate cancels his/her admission after physical reporting, an amount of Rs. 3,000/- only will be refunded to the candidate.

The refund process will begin after the entire admission process is completed. Therefore, the refund may take 3–4 months. As per the refund policy available at <https://admissions.nitw.ac.in/impinstructions/>, the eligible refund amount will be credited to the candidates' bank account only.

9. **At the time of online registration through SMILE ERP portal and the physical reporting, the list of documents to be submitted is given below:**

Two recent passport size photographs & Original certificates for verification and two sets of Xerox copies of the following certificates:

- i. Class X / SSC Certificate in support of Date of Birth.
- ii. SC/ST/PwD certificate.
- iii. Class XII / Intermediate / (10+2) Certificate.
- iv. Provisional Certificate/Degree Certificate and Marks Sheets of the qualifying examination (in case, the candidate is appearing for the final examinations, the candidate should produce the marks memoranda / grade sheets of all the examinations up to pre-final year/semester).
- v. Course Completion Certificate (Issued by the Head of the Institute, in case of present final year/semester results are awaited). All the pending documents shall be submitted on or before **September 30, 2026** failing which the allotted seat will be cancelled.
- vi. Original Transfer Certificate issued from the Institute last studied/attended. **In the absence of it, the candidate has to produce an email or a letter from the Institute last studied/attended stating that my Institute doesn't issue a separate transfer certificate.**
- vii. Original Migration Certificate.
- viii. Study and Conduct Certificate.
- ix. Aadhaar card (Xerox Copy)
- x. Proof of Bank account in SBI (in the name of the student): upload either a scanned copy of the cheque leaf or front page of the passbook or the latest bank statement.
- xi. APAR ID (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry ID)
- xii. GATE score card (if any)

Note: Submit **1 Set** of photocopies of all the above 12 documents (excluding the photograph).

10. At the time of physical reporting, the following **original certificates** should be submitted:
- Original Transfer Certificate issued from the Institute last studied/attended. **In the absence of it, the candidate has to produce an email or a letter from the Institute last studied/attended stating that my Institute doesn't issue a separate transfer certificate.**
 - Original Migration Certificate.
 - Filled-in Bio-data form (Annexure-1).
 - Filled-in Medical Certificate and Undertaking forms (Annexure-2 to 7).
11. The admission is **PROVISIONAL** and subject to production of all the required original documents mentioned above at the time of physical reporting to the Institute. Also, at the time of physical reporting to the Institute, if any certificate is found incorrect or the candidate does not meet the eligibility conditions of our Institute (visit admissions portal <https://admissions.nitw.ac.in/> for more details), the admission stands cancelled. Such candidates are eligible to get the refund as per Institute rules.
12. The candidate has to pay **Rs. 60,000/-** towards tuition fee and contingency in each of second, third and fourth semesters. An amount of **Rs. 15,000/-** will be collected towards the other fee along with third semester tuition fee.

STEPS TO BE FOLLOWED BY CANDIDATES FOR DOCUMENTS UPLOAD IN NITWAS AND PHYSICAL REPORTING FOR PHD ADMISSION AT NIT WARANGAL

1. Login to NITWAS Portal

- Upload all **required documents** as per the list provided in the admission instructions.
 - Once the **online verification is complete**, download and **take a printout of your PROFILE** from the **NITWAS** portal.
 - This PROFILE must be **submitted during physical reporting** at NIT Warangal.

2. Physical Reporting at NIT Warangal

- All **selected candidates must report in person** as per the schedule notified.
 - Bring all **original certificates** for final verification.
 - Submit original documents as per the institute's instructions after successful verification.

Important Notes:

- **Candidates will not be allowed for physical reporting without completing verification through the NITWAS portal.**
 - If a candidate is **unable to download the PROFILE**, it indicates that:
 - Their **PhD admission is either rejected**, or
 - A **query has been raised** regarding their documents.
 - If the candidate **fails to resolve the query** within the stipulated time, they will be **deemed ineligible for PhD admission**.
 - It is strongly advised that all candidates **check their NITWAS portal regularly** to ensure verification is complete and to avoid last-minute issues.
